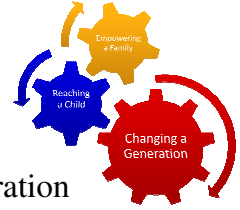


PIC Committee Meeting Minutes

"Friends for Sight"	Terri Smith	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Promotes vision - Protect, preserve, and promote vision - Preschool screening - Protect vision through safety ware like goggles during sports - Screen older adults for things like glaucoma - Terri is the chairman for the preschool screening - Go into the preschools to screen; go to preschools w/ minimum of 20 students since they are just starting this program in Utah County - Use trained volunteers to help with screening - Nonprofit organization

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - You can see a \$2 donation checkbox on your driver license renewal, annual license plate renewal, and vehicle registration - The question was raised, “What if we service children who aren’t affiliated with a preschool?” “Friends for sight” works more closely w/ the preschool population. Terri Smith will raise this question at her next meeting and tell us the answer at the next PIC meeting. - Have insurance through VSP for those families who need it (a vision insurance) - 6 weeks after a negative vision screening, “Friends for Sight” follows up w/ the family to see if they took their child to the ophthalmologist - “Kids Who Count” explored the question of advertising to parents about having “Friends for Sight” do vision screening at their facilities
